Pop into one of the Tourist Information Centres in Kandos or Rylstone and pick up brochures on walks, drives and attractions.

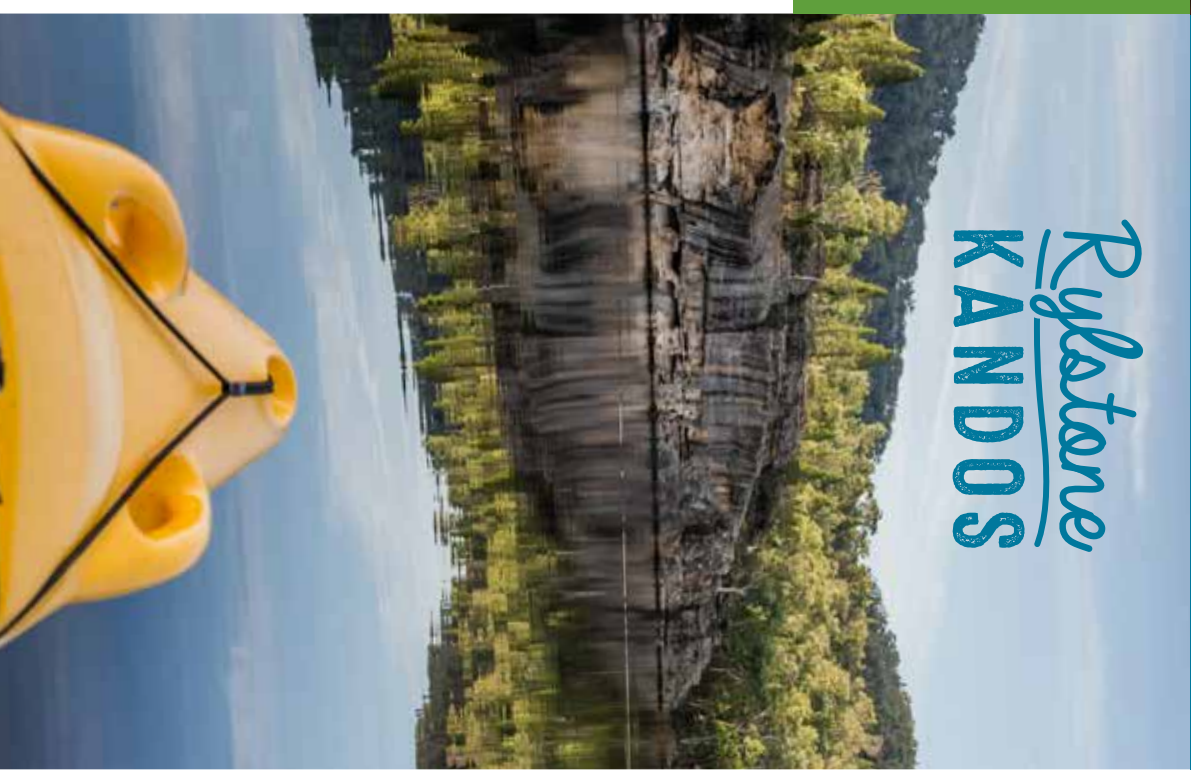

Taste-test our wine, olive oil, saffron and other produce from our local farms and business outlets. You'll go home with a treat.

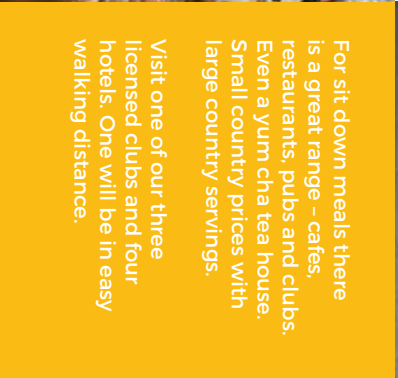
The Globe and The Rylstone Hotel and local clubs offer social games, drinks, family food and welcoming locals.

Fast food companies have not yet invaded our towns. Our food outlets are much better. We do great coffee too!



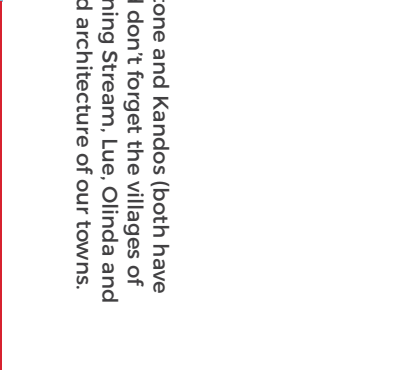
Explore

Walk around the towns of Rylstone and Kandos (both have self guided heritage walks) and don't forget the villages of Chabon, Clandulla, Ilford, Running Stream, Lue, Olinda and Bylong. Discover the history and architecture of our towns.



For sit down meals there is a great range – cafes, restaurants, pubs and clubs. Even a yun cha tea house. Small country prices with large country servings.

Visit one of our three licensed clubs and four hotels. One will be in easy walking distance.

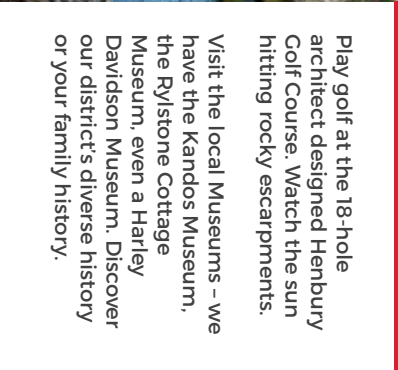


Walk or cycle on the dedicated tracks between Kandos and Rylstone. Or walk along a quiet country road. You might find wild asparagus and apple trees fruiting and there's even someone growing truffles.

Swim at the world class Kandos Swimming Pool. There's a toddler and an Olympic-sized heated pool.

Play golf at the 18-hole architect designed Henbury Golf Course. Watch the sun hitting rocky escarpments.

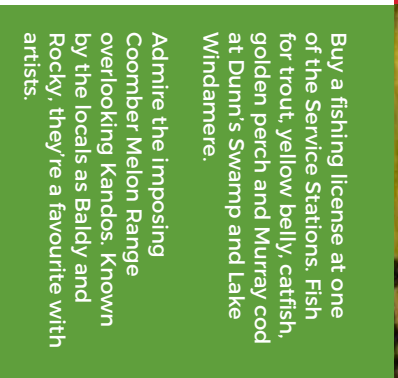
Visit the local Museums – we have the Kandos Museum, the Rylstone Cottage Museum, even a Harley Davidson Museum. Discover our district's diverse history or your family history.



Parks & Wildlife

Visit Ganguddy/ Dunn's Swamp – it's not a swamp, rather a beautiful waterway. Hire a kayak. Go for a swim. Or a bushwalk and spot the wildlife. Photograph the landscape. Have a BBQ. Camping available.

Bushwalk in Ferritree Gully, the Wollemi National Park, Lake Windamere or the Gardens of Stone National Park. Take a picnic with you.



Buy a fishing license at one of the Service Stations. Fish for trout, yellow belly, catfish, golden perch and Murray cod at Dunn's Swamp and Lake Windamere.

Admire the imposing Coomber Melon Range overlooking Kandos. Known by the locals as Baldy and Rocky, they're a favourite with artists.

Sit and watch the birds. You are likely to spot king parrots, galahs, cockatoos, koels, friarbirds, blackbirds, wedgetail eagles, fairy wrens, spinebills, double barred finches, willy wagtails and cheeky magpies. Capertee Valley boats being one of the top bird watching locations in the world.



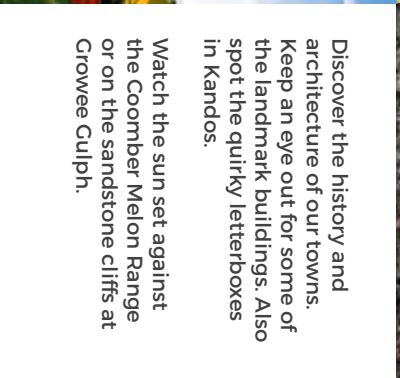
Pick up a local paper (Mudgee Guardian or Community Capers).

Art
